





Eight wineries located on the wine trail will offer tastings of locally produced wine paired with locally made cheeses on Saturday, June 15 from 11:00 AM to 6:00 PM and on Sunday, June 16 from 11:00 AM to 5:00 PM. For the advance purchase ticket price of \$30, ticket holders will enjoy tastings of four locally hand-crafted wines at each winery paired with small plates of locally produced fine cheeses.

The Upper Hudson Valley Wine Trail cannot accommodate groups larger than eight (8) people for this event and strongly recommends that each group have a designated driver. Designated drivers tickets are only \$5.00 and entitles the ticket holder to taste the locally made cheeses provided. Regular advance purchase tickets are \$30.00 per person, while At-the-Door tickets will be available for \$35.00 per person.

About the Upper Hudson Valley Wine Trail

Founded by the not-for-profit Upper Hudson Valley Wine & Grape Association and launched in 2013, the **Upper Hudson Valley Wine Trail** brings together the family-owned wineries of New York's Warren, Saratoga and Washington Counties. **Stretching from Lake George to Saratoga Springs and Easton**, NY, the 12 members of the Upper Hudson Valley Wine Trail include **farm vineyards**, locally-owned **wineries** and **tasting rooms**, and **satellite tasting rooms** of two Finger Lakes' wineries. The members of the Upper Hudson Valley Wine & Grape Association are continually working to increase public awareness and support of the local wine & grape industry. The Upper Hudson Valley Wine Trail is currently working with Assemblyman Tony Jordan and Senator Betty Little to introduce legislation to officially designate the Upper Hudson Valley Wine Trail under the program administered by the New York Department of Transportation.
